- **Monday, May 1st – AP TESTING – Monday, May 1st through Friday, May 14th students will be taking AP exams. Please see the AP exam dates, times and testing format listed below:**
 - Students should report to the morning testing sites by 7:30 am and afternoon sites by 11:30 am. Afternoon tests may run until 4:00 pm. Please make necessary transportation arrangements so that your child can arrive on time. Take into consideration that traffic coming from West Little Rock is heavy in the morning. Per College Board, cell phones and SMART WATCHES are prohibited in the AP testing rooms. If a cell phone is discovered during testing, the student(s) will be dismissed, his/her score will be canceled, and the phone will be confiscated per LRSD Rule 24. Possession/Use of Paging Devices, Cellular Phones and /or Electronic Communication Devices. In addition, students(s) will not be able to earn weighted credit. Food and beverages are NOT permitted in the testing area, but snacks can be eaten between exams. PTSA provides water and crackers.
 - Per state mandate, students must take their AP exams to receive weighted credit for the AP class. Students may be excused from other classes all day on the days they have an exam – ONLY! However, it is the students' responsibility to keep up with any assignments, semester reviews, etc., in the missed classes. Once again, we are administering over 1,900 exams. - **Monday, May 15 - Thursday, May 18 are Senior Exams.** Please refer to the attached calendar.
- **Monday, May 22nd is the due date for Seniors to submit their Senior Surveys in Naviance.** Graduating seniors who have accepted scholarships (academic and athletic) and/or received any military aid and would like to be recognized in the Class of 2023 Graduation Program must submit a verification form with documentation (name of scholarship(s), award amount, and attending school) to Ms. Medley in the Guidance Office. Scholarships/Grants/Awards Verification forms are located with her in the guidance office and all forms must be returned to Ms. Medley as soon as possible. **A firm due date will be shared with graduating seniors soon!...NO EXCEPTIONS! Only scholarships that are accepted and documented will be recognized in the program!**
