## **The Gates Scholarship**

The Gates Scholarship (TGS) is a highly selective, last-dollar scholarship for outstanding, minority high school seniors from low-income households. Each year, the scholarship is awarded to exceptional student leaders with the intent of helping them realize their maximum potential.

### **Basic Eligibility**

#### **To apply, students must be:**

- A high school senior
- From at least one of the following ethnicities: African-American, American Indian/Alaska Native\*, Asian & Pacific Islander American, and Hispanic American
- Pell-eligible
- A US citizen, national, or permanent resident
- In good academic standing with a minimum cumulative weighted GPA of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent)
- Additionally, a student must plan to enroll full-time in a four-year degree program at a US-accredited, not-for-profit, private or public college or university.

\*For American Indians/Alaska Natives, proof of tribal enrollment will be required.

### **Ideal Candidate**

#### **An ideal candidate will have:**

- An outstanding academic record in high school (in the top 10% of their graduating class)
- Demonstrated leadership ability (e.g., as shown through participation in community service, extracurricular, or other activities)

- Exceptional personal success skills (e.g., emotional maturity, motivation, perseverance, etc.)

**Scholarship Amount:** The cost of attendance includes tuition, fees, room, board, books, and transportation and may include other personal expenses.

Applying for the Heisman High School Scholarship is your chance to be rewarded and gain local, state, and even national recognition for all you've put into your high school career. If you've maintained at least a B average, participate in at least one of the school-sponsored sports recognized by the [International Olympic Committee in the Summer and Winter Olympic Games](#), the [Paralympic Games](#), or the [National Federation of State High School Associations](#), are a leader in your community and role model at your school, then you've got what it takes.

### Eligibility

- Students must be seniors during the 2023-2024 academic year, graduating with the class of 2024.
- Have a cumulative weighted high school grade point average (GPA) of a B (3.0) or better.
- Participated in grades 9,10, or 11 in at least one of the sports recognized by the International Olympic Committee in the Summer and Winter Games, the Paralympic Games, or the National Federation of State High School Association.
- Be a leader in school and the community and serve as a role model for upper-level students

**Scholarship Amount:** State Winners: \$1,000.00 National Finalists: \$2,000.00 and National Winners: \$10,000.000

Coca-Cola Scholars are selected each year to receive a \$20,000 scholarship.

**To be eligible for consideration, applicants must be:**

- Current high school/home-schooled students attending school in one of the 50 U.S. states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, or select DoD schools who will graduate high school during the 2023-2024 academic school year (*students graduating from an American or ex-pat school abroad are not eligible for this award; individuals who have already graduated from high school are not eligible*).
