IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER:

- **PSAT Test OCT 12th – All 10th graders will take the PSAT at no cost. 11th grade students** who would like to take the PSAT may sign up online using a credit card <https://lrsd1.schoolcashonline.com/> from **Tuesday, September 6th – Saturday, September 24th** or in their English class. The cost is \$18.00. Checks should be made payable to Central High School and include your child's ID number on the memo line.
- **PSAT prep classes** will be offered during TASC **Tuesday, September 20th – Thursday, September 22th and Tuesday, September 27th – Thursday, September 29th** from 4:00pm- 5:30pm on the 4th floor for anyone wishing to attend. These prep classes are designed for 11th grade students who will be taking the PSAT. These workshops have proven results with raising PSAT scores.
- **Mock PSAT Tests** will be given in the Central High Library on **Saturday, September 17th and Saturday, September 24th** from 9:00am until 12:30pm. Please be on time. There is no cost for the Mock PSAT or the prep class.
- **IT Technology:** Chromebook Insurance can be purchased online from School Device Coverage . The cost is \$25 for the full year. Insurance covers any damage to the device, lost devices, and stolen devices. Accessories are not covered (chargers). Tutoring Opportunities:

- **Tutoring for all students** needing assistance will be prominently posted on our website. Many students are already taking advantage of our teacher/student support system.
- **TEACHER ACADEMIC SUPPORT CENTER (TASC):** TASC will begin offering tutoring **Wednesday, September 14th** in the following subject areas: English, Math, Science, Social Studies and Foreign Language. Students enrolled in Credit Recovery may also attend. TASC is located on the 4th floor Tuesday – Thursday from 4:00pm to 5:30pm. Test Makeup Center is Monday - Thursday afternoons from 4:00-5:30 and Tuesday - Thursday mornings from 7:30-8:30.
